

Blindspot (available now)



Heat unfolds to the backdrop of the looming Australian bushfire season when two families who are long-time friends, venture to a secluded home for a summer vacation. As secrets and lies unravel, it becomes a tinderbox – and not everyone will make it out alive.



The Hunted (working title)

The Hunted follows the story of young, single mother Rachel and her young son Liam, living on the poverty line, Rachel working all hours of the day to provide the best life she can for them. One day, she is approached by Elliot - an extremely wealthy client who is a regular guest at the hotel she cleans at - to work for him exclusively. Better pay, fewer hours - it sounds too good to be true. But gradually Elliot's behaviour towards Rachel and Liam becomes increasingly controlling. When suspicions are raised, Rachel starts to dig into his past, uncovering a dark and disturbing story from his childhood that explains his obsession with them. What ensues is a nail-biting thriller that asks the question: how far would you go to repair your past?

The Good Ship Murder (available now)

The Good Ship Murder (w/t) is set aboard a luxury cruise liner touring everyone's favourite Mediterranean holiday hotspots bubbling with intrigue, rivalries, glamour, money and class divides – but its new cabaret singer, ex detective Jack Grayling, soon discovers there are also more sinister elements below the surface. On a cruise out of Southampton, Jack meets newly promoted First Officer, Kate Woods. Fierce and ambitious, she's a woman in a man's world with plenty to prove. After a passenger is found murdered in their first port of call, Kate's dream of her own command is thrown into jeopardy and Jack finds himself thrust back into his former life as a detective. What follows is a wave of murder mysteries – each set against the backdrop of a different stunning coastal destination where the ship has dropped anchor.

Night Caller

A contemporary thriller based in Liverpool about a lonely 50-something taxi driver, Tony, from Liverpool and his growing obsession with a late-night Radio DJ called Lawrence.

Robert Glenister (Sherwood, Spooks) plays Tony, a 50-something cab driver from Liverpool, who used to be a respected teacher but lost his job, his confidence, and his marriage. His only lifelines are cafe-worker Rosa, played by Suzanne Packer (Casualty, In My Skin), whom he forms a growing attachment to, and a late-night radio talk-show host called Lawrence, portrayed by Sean Pertwee (Dog Soldiers, Elementary, Gotham) who he spends his nights listening to as he ferries passengers across the city.

One day Tony plucks up the courage to ring Lawrence on-air and soon becomes a "friend of the show" - for the first time in years, he feels listened to. But, as time passes, he starts to interpret Lawrence's "world view" in dangerous ways.

Lastly, Alex Gaumond is back as Chief of Police André Caron, along with Tony Robinson, returning as Dom's light-fingered Uncle Patrick.




Wonders of the Moon with Dara O'Briain






Dogs Behaving (Very) Badly


